

OYC Mac and Back Race No 2 – Saturday 29 April 2023 starting at 10:30 hrs

This is an Impromptu race for the Winter season.

There is no cup for the winner, maybe just a certificate and the satisfaction of the placing.

There is no entry fee and no organised food afterwards. The bar of course will be open as usual from 4 to 6pm

The race is open to all yachts. Normal club handicaps apply. Communication of VHF Ch 77. HWDN 11:21 hrs (1.7 M)

Manual entries are taken at the Clubhouse from 09:30 hrs on the day. Briefing at 10:00 hrs

The Start / Finish Line is the transit line of Red Pile 64, the white pole on the marina sea wall & the Clubhouse balcony Flag pole.

There is a single start for all yachts. Signals will be conducted from the Clubhouse balcony Flag pole.

A five minute Start sequence will begin from 10:25 hrs provided there is no commercial traffic in the channel.

Note: Mark T is the “three legs” piles and the lower turning mark is green Pile ‘P’.

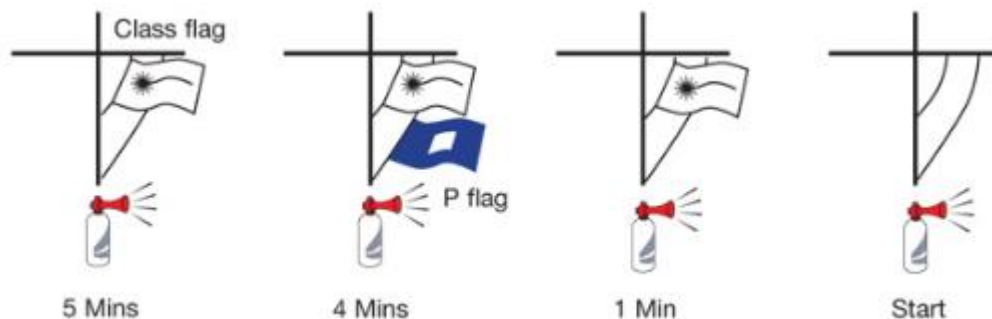
Warning: Keep clear of mud banks at the mouth of the Leith as they come out to the edge of the channel.

Course: Clubhouse Start Line / proceed up the channel with a PORT rounding of Red Pile 76 (This is by the old Port Otago slipway by the Harbour Basin) / Head toward Macandrew Bay passing Green Pile Q to PORT / Make a PORT rounding of Green Pile P and head back up the harbour / Pass Green Pile Q to STARBOARD / make a STARBOARD rounding of Green Piles T (Three Legs) and proceed to the Finish line.

In the event of commercial traffic in the channel at the finish, stay on the right hand side of the rock wall to pass the extended Finish line.

Safety: Buoyancy vests or lifejackets should be worn at all times while afloat.
