
## Sailing instructions OYC Principal Day 20th January 2024






These instructions are to be read in conjunction with the NOR previously published

Courses will be set in the Upper Harbour according to the winds on the day but will, unless advised otherwise, have the shape and form shown below.

Any variations to these instructions will be advised at the briefing at 1000hrs at the OYC Clubrooms

Radio: VHF channel 77



Map is not to scale, the distance from the Start to 1 and 1a will be determined on the day according to wind strength.



Courses will be windward / leeward from start to top then to mark 2P or 2S, laid as a gate. Other than the gate, all marks will be port rounding.

On the last lap of each course boats will sail past mark 3 for a windward finish. Boats are requested not to sail downwind through the start line.

2 laps for TY A, B, divisions, keelers, Senior dinghies. Start, 1, 2(p,s) 1, 3, Finish

3 laps sport boats. Start, 1, 2(p,s) 1, 2(p,s) 1, 3, Finish

2 laps for junior dinghies, TY C division. Start, 1a, 2(p,s.) 1a, 3, Finish

All dinghies start together Flag

All Trailer yachts / sport boats, start together Flag T

Keelers Flag K likely to start with TY



Depending on numbers, Keelers may be started with Trailer Yachts

Up to three races will be sailed. One race sailed counts as a regatta for scoring purposes. No discards

Flag K

Start sequence will be 5 minutes

Boats not in a start sequence must keep clear of boats already in a start sequence

Start boat will be the catamaran 'Minx' Ch 77

Entries can be taken at the Clubrooms from 0930 if you have not already entered online.

First warning signal will be at 1055.

There will be a social function with a cash bar and BBQ to follow.
